This book describes, defines and demonstrates the clinical applications of transference and projection and how they are used by psychotherapists as 'mirrors to the self'.

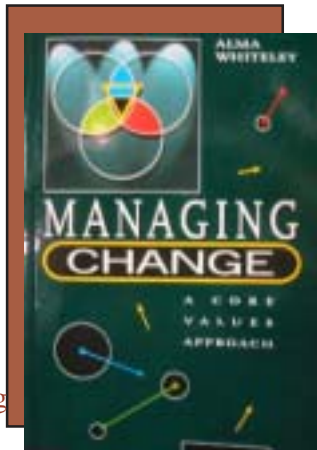

FRIENDSHIP IS A SHELTERING TREE

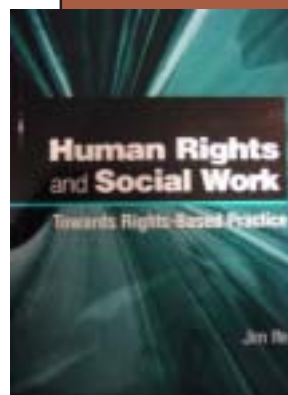
John Curtin's Letters 1907 - 1945.
